- 5) Discussed the recently formed Heartland Health Clinic, which is being established to care for certain medical needs among members of the local Mennonite community.

- 6) Leon Heatwole, member of the Deacon Search Committee, reported that a potential deacon candidate has been contacted and is working with Overseer Steve Estep on filling out the appropriate questionnaires.
- 7) Council continued its discussion of pros and cons of both voting and gifts-discernment options for filling church positions.
- 8) Received names for filling various church positions.
- 9) Council expressed appreciation to outgoing members Terry Cline, Diane Eberly and Leon Heatwole for their time and effort in serving the congregation in this way.
