It is the time of year in Red Lake when everything seems ready to spring into the action of summer, but we are forced to wait. Temperatures still go below freezing at night, the lakes are still white with ice, and fishing season is CLOSED until May 15. Spiritually I feel like God is taking the chance to teach me more about waiting and learning to respond to His calling only when I know I've heard His voice (I thought I had learned this ten years ago). It is too easy for me to pursue what I want, pursue what I see, pursue what I feel and plunge ahead with out listening. I'm humbled by the times I've done this, thinking I'm doing what God called me too and realize over and over again that what God called me to looks more like a relationship than an accomplishment. My request for prayer this month is that I will have the courage to wait and respond only when I hear Him say "GO, I'm sending you."
